

**CITY OF THREE FORKS**  
**"JEFFERSON RIVER FLOOD MITIGATION SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT AND MAINTENANCE DISTRICT"**

The Three Forks City Council will hold a public hearing on a Resolution of Intent to Create a Special Improvement District to be named "Jefferson River Flood Mitigation and Maintenance District" on September 27, 2022, at 6PM at City Hall, 206 Main Street, Three Forks, MT 59752. The City of Three Forks submitted funding applications to FEMA in January 2022 for the purposes of funding a flood mitigation project to reduce flood risk from the Jefferson River. The proposed mitigation is a grass-line conveyance channel and culvert crossing improvement project that will intercept flood waters west of town and divert them back to the Jefferson River.

The conveyance channel would be approximately 8,000 lineal feet. Channel dimensions are anticipated to be 100-foot wide, 5-foot deep, with 3:1 side slopes. The project will include a culvert crossing structure to carry water underneath Hwy 2 before terminating into a natural side channel of the Jefferson River. The project cost is estimated at \$5.5 million. The City learned that FEMA has selected Three Forks for final review of a Flood Mitigation Assistant Grant at 75% of the total project cost. The purpose of the proposed district would be to fund the remaining 25% construction cost, and annual maintenance cost, of the Jefferson River Flood Mitigation and Maintenance.
